**June 27 - July 15, 2010**

The Conservative Yeshiva Summer Program features the opportunity to study the classic texts of Judaism, including Rabbinic literature, Bible and Jewish Thought. This year it will include the study of the Nusach Hat'fillah for Sh'lichei Tsibbur – leaders of prayer.

**Intensive Ulpan** to build Hebrew speaking and reading skills.

**Learning** appropriate for students of all levels, backgrounds and interests.

**Courses** built on the traditional model of chevruta, learning one-on-one with a partner, and shiur, a seminar-style class.

**Mornings** – Feature intensive Ulpan at five levels or Talmud study, beginning or advanced

**Afternoons** – Include Nusach Hat'fillah for Sh'lichei Tsibbur, text classes in Bible, Rabbinics, Jewish Thought, Halacha, Liturgy and more, plus skills workshops, tours and volunteering

expenses.**
